Information, Rules, and Code of Conduct

1. Vendors must supply their own shade canopy/tent, tables, and chairs. All canopies/tents must be tagged with state fire marshal approval.
2. Vendors (commercial participants) must have a photocopy of your Business/Resale License. You are also solely responsible for collecting and reporting any applicable taxes for your business.
3. All participants will conduct themselves in a well behaved and lawful manner at all times.
4. Participants will be responsible for all members of their party.
5. Tents with side walls larger than 400 sq. ft. need a permit from the San Diego Fire Department.
6. Staking is not allowed by Balboa Park rules, so in case of windy weather, you may want to bring sandbags or other weights for your tents/canopies.
7. Saturday morning setup starts at 7:00 a.m.
8. All booths: should be setup and ready by 8:30 a.m.
9. No open flames are allowed in booth area.
10. Children under 12 years of age must be attended by a responsible adult at all times.
11. No nudity, alcohol, nor drugs.
12. There will be no moving of booths once they are assigned except by Promoter. You are renting an assigned space. We will take requests into consideration; however the Promoter (Vendor Coordinator) has the final say.
13. Food Vendors: You must attach a photocopy of your valid Special Event Health Permit before your application will be processed. All food vendors must post a health permit in their booths in addition to attaching it to this application. All food vendors must have a certified fire extinguisher in their booth. Vendors are responsible for knowing and meeting all Health Department regulations. Be prepared for a visit from the Health Department and our inspector.
14. The Promoter reserves the right to limit the number of applications for any one particular type of good/service, thereby protecting all vendors and maintaining diversity for the event. The Promoters also have the right to change or substitute vendor spaces for the good of the event and its participants. No stolen merchandise, firearms, ammunition, nor drugs are allowed on the grounds.

These Rules will be strictly enforced. Any violation may result in the forfeiture of any fees/donations given and immediate banishment from the event.
